To the parents, teachers, and community of La Salle,

From 31 January next year, a rebate will be made available to help parents and guardians cover some of the often demanding costs of keeping kids active.

One \$100 voucher will be available for all schoolchildren aged 4.5 to 18 in NSW – including all students enrolled in Catholic secondary schools such as La Salle. These can be used against the registration and membership costs of organised children's sport and physical recreational activities. The sport or activity must run over a period of at least eight weeks.

The vouchers can be redeemed at any point of the calendar year in which they are claimed. They are only limited to one per child - there is no limit on the number that may be claimed per family.

Parents and guardians can register for a voucher at Services NSW centres – including the local centre at Bankstown Central – or through the website of the NSW Office of Sport ([sport.nsw.gov.au](http://sport.nsw.gov.au)).
